



2025 Scholarship Application Guidelines

MidSouth Electric Co-op awards numerous scholarships worth \$1,500.00 each year to area high school seniors within MidSouth service territory.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Parent or Legal Guardian must be a MidSouth Electric Co-op member.
- Student must be living with the Parent or Legal Guardian whose permanent residence is in the MidSouth Electric Co-op Service Territory.
- Student must be a 2025 graduating senior entering a College, University, Trade or Technical School.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed application (no resumes) with the following attachments:
- Student's official transcript signed by a school official, certified with the school seal and converted to a 4.0 scale. Transcript must also show SAT/ACT scores.
 - If high school transcript does not reflect SAT/ACT scores, please submit proof of scores.
 - If SAT/ACT not required for school of choice, student must submit proof of acceptance.
- Brief statement by school counselor regarding applicant **or** three letters of recommendation from school officials and/or teachers.
 - If homeschooled, three letters of recommendation from community members, club sponsors, coaches or church clergy will be accepted.
- Essay (1-2 pages typed) detailing, "Why I should receive this scholarship".
- High Quality Photo – senior photo or headshot, to be used for newspaper and magazine publication.

Incomplete applications or missing required documents will subject applicant to disqualification. Students not attending school within one year from the date of the scholarship will forfeit the scholarship funds.
